MEMBERSHIP:

FACILITIES:

Sold the C rake received \$1500- (there is a commission to pay)

Work Party: There were only 3 volunteers. Worked on fencing, replaced missing boards, identified next priority planks that need replacing. Weed whipping was done and weeds pulled along perimeter of the large ring. Claire tidied the concession area.

There is a vine weed growing on far side off large sand ring-possible morning glory. Should contact CRD and get help from the BEES for eradication.

The gate post on the warm up ring needs to be replaced (the small gate). We need to obtain a quote from Tidy Line so that it can be repaired at the same time as the round pen construction.

Need to have hearing protection available for volunteers. Will need to purchase ear protection AND, need to locate protective eye wear and put it all together in one place. Motion approved to spend around \$150.00 for protective gear (hearing protection/face shield)

Manure signs have not been put up yet.

Signs for dog walkers to keep dogs on leash during events- Multiple signs were provided by CRD. We have 2 sandwich boards to mount them on, need to acquire a third one ideally.

There is an empty locker that can be used to store the signs.

ROUNDPEN PROJECT:

We will need approval from Saanich regarding possible fire hazard when the existing metal fencing has to be cut apart during removal. Cutting the metal may cause sparks and therefore a fire hazard. Need to have hoses available.

Horse council could not give the full \$5000.00 grant, we only received \$2500.00. Tidy Line will give EBLES a significant discount if Tidy Line can advertise. CRD will not allow direct advertising at the site. BUT we CAN put anything we want on our social media and website. We are also allowed to put up a sign thanking the donor.

CRD never paid for turtle fencing boards on large ring. Can approach Rachel at CRD to see if will pay for bottom boards on round pen and follow up on reimbursement for the large ring turtle fencing.

EVENTS:

Poker Ride June 14th:

- Ted will put up markers June 13, map is on google drive. Jenny has copies of maps

-Prizes need to be labeled with Donor information ahead of time so that set up is easy

-need to print out maps

-computer and hand sorter program. Dianne to download java script program.

-need a volunteer for the 50:50 draw. Claire will look into a person for this.

-Diane will bring extra table

-Jenny proposed approaching horse suppliers for prizes next year early in the year. Requires 5-6 month lead up. Would need to have confirmed date for the poker ride well in advance
